Weatherization Assistance Program

Ninth District Opportunity's Weatherization Assistance Program is **FREE** to qualifying households meeting all eligibility requirements.

WEATHERIZATION SERVICES

The Weatherization Assistance Program will conduct a building science-based residential energy audit.

The energy audit will address energy usage and limited aspects of building durability and occupant health and safety.

The energy audit will provide a comprehensive report with a list of prioritized recommendations to improve the home and will include a cost-benefit analysis.

A review will be conducted with the home owner/occupant after the audit is completed. This may include: combustion safety testing results on any gas appliances tested, any health and safety hazards or concerns if found, results of diagnostic testing, and potential energy conservation measures that may be installed.



Energy Conservation Measures and Health and Safety Measures may include:

- **Attic Insulation**
- **Floor Insulation**
- **Sealing Air Leaks**
- **Window Repair**
- **Other Minor Repairs**
- **Smoke and CO Detectors**
- **LED Light Bulbs**
- **Heating and Cooling Repair or Replacement**
- **Refrigerator Replacement**



How to Apply for Services

- Contact the county office where you reside. Office locations and phone numbers are on the back of this brochure.
- If you are income eligible, you will be asked to complete an application for weatherization assistance services.
- Priority is given to the elderly, families with one or more members with a disability, families with children or high energy users.
- When your application is next on the list, you will be called to have an energy audit. Households that have persons in most need are often moved to the top of the list. If you rent, you must get permission from your landlord before work can begin on the house.
- Once the energy audit has been conducted, Ninth District Opportunity contractors will perform the energy conservation measures on the home and then a final inspection will be conducted to ensure work has been completed to the Department of Energy standards.
- Energy Audits and Final Inspections are conducted by Building Performance Institute (BPI) Certified individuals.
- Weatherization measures are installed by fully licensed and insured contractors.
