OUR PROGRAM

Goal setting, budgeting and wellness are hallmarks of our 90-day program. Additionally, we attend church services as a group and have weekly bible studies and devotionals. Our program takes a whole-person approach with a goal of equipping our residents with resources and support in all facets of their lives.

When a person is seeking assistance, they should start by contacting us directly. As space is available, we set up an in-person interview to discuss the expectations of our program in-depth and to get to know the potential resident.

Qualifications for Assistance

- You are committed to making positive changes in your life in order to better your situation.
- You are a homeless single woman or homeless mother with children.
- If you are not working, you must actively be looking for employment.
- You must be drug and alcohol free we randomly test residents.
- You are willing to abide by program rules, policies and commitment of conduct.
