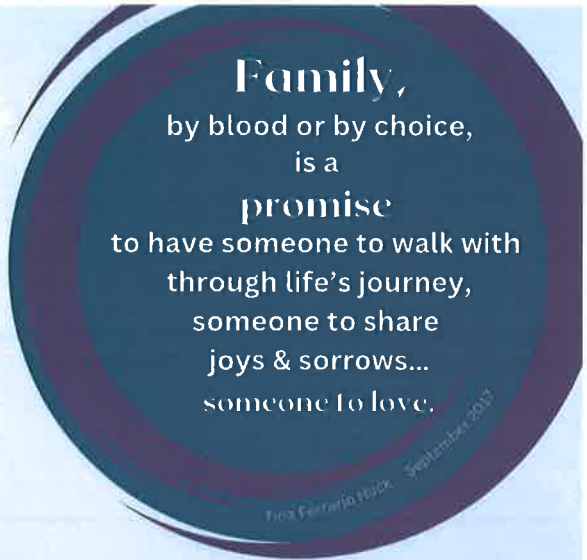


Our Programs

Our diverse programs are structured to serve families in our community who are experiencing homelessness and/or are facing housing or financial instability.

The primary requirements for each program are that the family has at least one child under the age of 18 and that the adults in the family are willing to work to attain stability for their family.



Rotational/Residential Program



Our Residential Program offers families a safe place to stay, meals and other basic needs, without cost, in order to save toward their own place while gaining skills and habits needed for sustainable independence.

Community Based Services

Our Community-Based Services offer varying levels of support for families facing housing and/or financial insecurity, but who do not need shelter at this time.

**These programs may also be utilized by families waiting for admission into our Residential Program.*

CBS Program - Prevention, Diversion, Stabilization

Our Prevention and Diversion programs meet families where they are by assessing their needs in order to avoid needing shelter placement. This can be as simple as assistance navigating available resources or applying for benefits to full case management creating a plan to attain truly sustainable independence. This program also provides supports and resources for graduates of our programs to maintain stability.

CBS Program - Resources (Items)

Thanks to some of our amazing partnerships, we are able to provide items such as clothing, birthday packs, back to school clothes, pajamas, etc. This may be on a one-on-one basis, at community/partner events, or at our Family Resource Festivals

Client Expectation	This is an initial intake or introductory level. There are no expectations to meet other than qualifying for our services.	Client is meeting weekly with Sustainability Coach and completing weekly goals.	Meeting minimally 2x per month with Sustainability Coach and completing goals.
