

Service providers offer identification recovery (Drivers Licenses, Social Security Cards, and birth certificates), benefit recovery (Social Security, Disability, and food stamps), Medicare/Medicaid, probation assistance/mediation, hot showers, mental health assistance, job training, transportation, health services/testing, birth control, phone programs, Hispanic Assistance, homeless veterinary services, substance abuse counseling, drug safety testing, and housing assistance.

StreetExit develops community wide service events for the unhoused and hurting. These events are supported by local community organizations, faith groups, businesses, civic organizations, and committed volunteers. Currently, StreetExit has organized ongoing projects in Hall, White/Habersham, and Dawson/Forsyth counties. StreetExit partners with other agencies for unhoused projects in Stephens and Lumpkin counties. Future expansion includes Rabun, Towns, and Banks counties.

StreetExit attempts to empower the individual by working together to reduce the existing barriers many homeless encounter. As these barriers crumble, opportunities for individual advancement, opportunity and independence become a greater possibility. We offer a “Hand Up” not a “Hand Out.”
