KINSHIP CARE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

- **CAPS-Child and Parent Services:** provides scholarships to families who need financial assistance paying for the cost of child care.
 - Qualifications:
 - Your child must be 12 years of age or younger, or 17 years of age or younger if the child has a qualifying disability or has a case plan requiring child care as part of court-ordered supervision
 - Your child must be a US Citizen or an authorized immigrant
 - Your child must be up to date on immunizations
 - Caregiver must meet state-approved activity requirements
 - Household gross income cannot exceed 50% of the state median income

- **Child Support Services:** includes locate services, paternity establishment, order establishment, order enforcement, redirection of child support payments, child support collection and distribution, review of support order

- **GRG-Grandparents Raising Grandchildren:** Refers to a financial assistance program designed to support grandparents who are raising their grandchildren
 - **MSP-Monthly Subsidy Payment:** an ongoing cash payment of \$50.00 per child per month
 - **CRISP-Crisis Intervention Services Payment CRISP:** a one-time emergency cash payment available to eligible grandparents in situations requiring immediate financial assistance.
 - Qualifications:
 - Grandparent must be the caretaker of his/her own grandchild
 - Grandparent must be 60 years of age or older, or
 - Grandparent must be disabled
 - Grandparent must receive TANF

- **Medicaid**

****Children who do not live with their biological or adoptive parents are eligible to receive TANF benefits on their own. Medicaid comes with TANF****

 - **Basic:** provides assistance with medical costs for people with limited income and resources
 - **Right From the Start Medicaid (RSM):** provides children under the age of 19, pregnant women, low-income families, and women with breast or cervical cancer assistance to receive comprehensive health services. (No-cost program)
 - **Peach Care for Kids:** primarily for children (under age 19) from families with incomes slightly above Medicaid eligibility levels (Can be a no-cost program or may require a small monthly premium)
 - Qualifications
 - Low income, US Citizen (or qualified alien) and
 - You think you are pregnant, or
 - You are a child or teenager, or
 - You are age 65 or older, or
 - You are legally blind, or
 - You have a disability, or
 - You need nursing home care

- **SNAP-Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program** (FKA Food stamps): provides monthly benefits to low-income households to help pay for the cost of food
 - Qualifications:
 - You are a citizen of the United States or have a certain legal alien status
 - You provide all of the required documents as proof of household's situation
 - The household's monthly income does not exceed the income limits based on the number of people who live in the household
 - The rent or mortgage payment, utility bills, and in some cases medical, child care, and support expenses are considered in eligibility determination if proof of these expenses are provided.

- **TANF-Temporary Assistance for Needy Families**: provides cash assistance to families with dependent children for a limited time (usually 48 months)
****Children who do not live with their biological or adoptive parents are eligible to receive TANF benefits on their own ****
 - Qualifications:
 - Have a child younger than 18 in the family unit
 - You must apply for and accept any other benefits you might be eligible for, like
 - Unemployment Compensation
 - Workman's Compensation
 - Supplemental Security Insurance (SSI)
 - Child support
 - You must be a US citizen or a lawful resident alien
 - A child must be "deprived" for one of the following reasons:
 - Continue absence from the home of at least one parent
 - Physical or mental incapacity of at least one parent
 - Death of a parent
 - All members of the family must have or apply for a Social Security Number
 - All school-aged children must attend school
 - All preschool children must be immunized
 - The family income and assets are within TANF limits
 - The paternity of all children must be established when you apply for TANF
 - You must cooperate with the Office of Child Support Services

- **WIC- Women, Infants, & children Assistance**: designed to enhance the health and well-being of eligible families in Georgia. Offers nutritional education, access to healthy foods, breastfeeding support, and referrals to other community programs.
 - Qualifications
 - Must live in Georgia
 - Meet income requirements
 - Have a child under 5 years old, including foster children (parents, grandparents, and guardians encouraged to apply)
 - Women who are pregnant, breastfeeding, or postpartum
